



Kevin Murnane Coaching Development Grant

Kevin Murnane served as manager and director of Tahoe XC from 1999 to 2015. His passion and smile were instrumental in rallying skiers and friends around our community-based, non-profit, cross-country ski organization. He expanded the [local youth programs](#) and supported the local middle and high school Nordic ski teams. Thanks in a large part to Kevin's vision and passion, Tahoe XC still provides free weekly clinics and hosts community events like the Alpenglöw 20k, the Great Ski Race and the Tahoe Rim Tour. He brought infectious enthusiasm and love for Nordic skiing to Tahoe Cross-Country.



Kevin understood the need for quality coaching and for developing strong youth programs. The Kevin Murnane Coaching Development Grant is designed to support hard-working coaches who mentor our young North Tahoe athletes and who need financial support to attend clinics, symposiums, classes and trainings.

This grant is awarded each year on June 1st with funding up to \$1,000 per grant. Recipients must provide receipts for the grant monies to be applied. At the time of application, applicants must provide proof that they are currently employed or volunteering as coaches and/or mentors for a Tahoe City and/or North Lake Tahoe program (North Tahoe Middle or High School, Tahoe XC, Strider Gliders, Junior Mt. Riders, etc.) and meet the above criteria and deadlines.

Applicants must send a cover letter; list of references; proof of employment and/or volunteerism; and Expression of Interest (EOI) explaining the nature of their need, how the funds will be used, funding timelines, and how the applicant will personally and professionally benefit from receiving the grant.

All applications will be acknowledged. Grant recipients will be notified via email. Grant recipients will be asked to provide the TCCSEA Board of Directors with a presentation, in person or in writing, of their experience(s) once the grant has been used.
